Conway.....Sudie Payne Daves, 74, wife of Reggie Daves, passed away Tuesday, August 16, 2016.

Born February 1, 1942 in Florence, she was the daughter of the late Jimmy and Sudie Payne. Following graduation from Winthrop College she taught school in Charleston. After marrying Reggie they did a tour with the Navy. She and her family moved to Conway in 1979. Sudie embraced life in Conway and enjoyed living by the Waccamaw River. She was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church. Many charitable and community organizations benefitted from Sudie's time and energy. Some of the things she most enjoyed were the beauty of flowers, spending time with family and friends, and fellowship with other artists. A gifted artist, Sudie left a beautiful mark through her paintings inspired by the natural world. Everyone who knew Sudie knows she loved to dance! Her conviviality was immediately apparent everywhere she went. She leaves us with a legacy of love, of family, fun, friendship, generosity, and gorgeous art.

Survivors include her loving husband of 49 years, Reggie Daves; her children, Sudie Daves Thomas (David) and Forrest Daves (Abby); her grandchildren, Dawson Daves, Garrett Thomas, and Haven Daves; her brother, Charles Payne (Cindy); her sister, Kay Swenson (Clay); and many other beloved nieces, nephews, cousins, and in-laws.
