Susan Edgerton Boles, age 81, died Sunday, July 2, 2017 in Murrells Inlet, SC.

Born on January 28, 1936, in Meridian, Miss, she was daughter of the late Vesta and Tracy Edgerton. Susan grew up in Asheville, NC. In 1953 she graduated from St. Genevieve of the Pines High School in Ashville as Salutorian. She received her B.A. Degree in Spanish from Duke University in 1957. Susan married her husband and soul mate of 58 years, Dick Boles on September 27, 1959 at Norfolk, VA Naval Base. She was a Licensed Unity Teacher, taught Spanish in various high schools as well as other subjects. She was the co-founder of Wisdom of the Ages lecture series in Myrtle Beach in 2000. She served as president of Myrtle Beach Toast Masters Club, published in Sassy, published poetry in the Murrells Inlet Poetry Journal and served as Spiritual Counselor and Teacher at Unity Church in Myrtle Beach, as well as Interim Spiritual Leader twice. She was President of Phi Mu Sorority at Duke University in 1956 & 1957. Susan was the Judicial Representative for Basset House at Duke in 1956 & 1957, was on the Dean's List, studied Spanish at the University of Mexico in 1958 and traveled extensively in Europe, China, India, Australia and Central/South America.

Survivors include her husband, Richard (Dick) Boles, Sr.; two sons, Richard J. Boles, Jr., of Garden City and Thomas G. Boles of Raleigh, NC; and her sister, Eugenia Fayssoux of Greensboro, NC.

A memorial service will be held at 2:00 PM Sunday, July 9, 2017 at Unity Church in Myrtle Beach. A second memorial service will be held at 11:00 AM Monday, July, 10, 2017 at St. Michael's Catholic Church with an inurnment to follow at St. Michael's Church.
