Conway.....Taylor "Tater-Tot" Lee McKinney, age 10, of Naples Drive died Tuesday, October 4, 2005 at the Medical University of South Carolina in Charleston following an illness. Taylor was born in Myrtle Beach, a daughter of Paul McKinney, Jr. and Dana McKinney. She attended Waccamaw Elementary School. Taylor enjoyed attending Camp Happy Days each summer, a non-profit camp supporting children with cancer and their families. She was always concerned about the feelings of others even during her own illness. Surviving in addition to her parents of Conway are: one sister, Chelsea McKinney of Conway; one brother, Bryant McKinney of Conway; paternal grandparents, Paul McKinney, Sr. of Fredricksburg, VA and Patsy and Grady Davis of Conway; maternal grandparents, Carolyn Watson of Conway and Jimmy and Diane Watson of Aiken, SC; paternal great grandmother, Avena Bullard of Pembroke, NC; and maternal great grandmother, Pauline Smith of Cheraw, SC. Funeral services will be held at 3:30 P.M. Thursday from Langston Baptist Church with Rev. Alvin Jackson and Rev. Marcus Fowler officiating. Burial will follow in Hillcrest Cemetery directed by Goldfinch Funeral Home, Conway Chapel. The family will receive friends at the funeral home from 6:00 until 8:00 P.M. Taylor's favorite color was purple and her family asks that those attending her service wear something purple to celebrate her life.
