Born in Tampa, Florida on April 12, 1941. He was the son of the late Richard Sampson Booth, Jr. and Christine Fowler. An outstanding football player at Chamberlain High School in Tampa, he was scouted by many colleges with major football programs including Alabama, Tennessee, Florida, Colorado, and Kansas, etc. He went to Kansas, along with several of his close friends. On April 8, 1972, he married the love of his life, Sandra Appleby. For the next thirty-seven years they were inseparable. He was an outstanding giant of a man known to most as "Bear." Gentle, kind, and loving; he valued his God, his family, and loyalty above everything. A devoted member and deacon of Waccamaw House of Worship, he eagerly pursued a relationship with God and enjoyed the singing of old time Hymns, with "Amazing Grace" being his favorite. Many recall seeing Terry wherever and whenever his help was needed, never seeking the spotlight and always willing to lend a hand. Quite a few young people looked to him as a mentor and he loved and encouraged them all. For many years, he was the owner of Booth Printing, Inc. of Conway, SC, Many saw him as a "born leader." He was a Charter Member of the Ronald Reagan Republican Task Force and an ardent Republican, a member of the SC Press Association, a former Jaycee, and received many awards and honors. A member of the SC Sheriffs Association, the Fraternal Order of Police, and ardent supporter of the SC Highway

Trooper Association His father having been an officer killed in the line of duty, a Paul Harris Fellow of the Rotary, and a lifetime member of the NRA who fervently believed in the second amendment, a member of the Conway Chamber of Commerce, and an avid supporter of the Horry County Museum and the Main Street Program. Men like him come along rarely. Son, brother, husband, father, grandfather, uncle, nephew, and friend: Terry, we know that you are now a member of God's army and the love and protection you gave us during your life will be magnified and continue with us throughout eternity. We will see you at the Eastern Gate of Heaven. Terry was predeceased by his two brothers, Richard Bill, Grey, and a sister, Ginger Booth Vaughn.
