Theodore "Ted" Anderson Jr., 80, passed away on Friday, April 20, 2018 at his home surrounded by his loving family.

Born in Southampton, NY, Ted was the son of the late Theodore Carl Anderson Sr. and Maud Clem Anderson. He was a graduate of Brown University. He served in the United States Marine Corps for four years and the Marine Reserves for nine years. He was honorably discharged at the rank of Captain. He was a buyer for Bloomingdales and Allied stores both in New York. He also owned and operated Ted's Market for twenty years.
