Thomas Andrew Hussey, age 77, left his earthly home to be with his Lord and Savior, Monday, June 27, 2005 after an illness. Mr. Hussey was born on November 13, 1927 in Sumter, SC, he was the twelfth child born to the late Robert M. and Rosa Riles Hussey. After serving in the United States Air Force, he moved to Myrtle Beach in 1953 to establish his home.
