Murrells Inlet, SC...Thomas Willett Andrew, II, known to his friends simply as Will, passed away peacefully Monday, June 20, 2011 at the home of his sister, surrounded by her and his parents, who loved him dearly.

Will was born on December 18, 1971 and grew up in Aynor. He graduated from Aynor High School in 1990. While there Will was active in all sports but excelled as quarterback of the football team, leading them to two Lower State Championships. He was inducted into the Aynor High School Athletic Hall of Fame and his jersey number "7" was retired. Will graduated from the University of South Carolina in 1994 and the University of South Carolina School of Law in 1998. Will was employed as an Assistant Solicitor by the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit Solicitor's office, where he was respected for his sense of justice and fair-mindedness. Will loved music and sports and always rooted for the Gamecocks. Most of all Will loved people, especially his family and friends.

Will is survived by his parents Tommy and Sherrill Andrew of Aynor, his sister Leigh Andrew and her husband Chip Beverly, his nephew Hal Thomas Beverly, all of Surfside Beach, his grandmother Mary Katherine Roberts of Galivants Ferry, his girlfriend Destiny Strickland of Conway, and his dog Cooper. He will be missed.

Funeral services will be held at 3 p.m. Thursday, June 23, 2011 at Aynor United Methodist Church with Rev. Tony Adams officiating. Burial will follow in the Aynor Cemetery.

The family will receive friends from 6-8 p.m. Wed. at the funeral home.
