Thomas Edward Cleary, age 81 formerly of Deerfield Plantation died Thursday, October 20, 2005 at National Healthcare of Garden City. Born February 13, 1924 in Bayonne, NJ, he was the son of the late James J. and Florence Kohanski Cleary. In 1942, he received a scholarship to study electrical engineering at Cornell which he attended until his studies there were interrupted when he was drafted into the Army Air Corps in 1944. He flew P-51s, P38s, P47s and P61 Nightfighters between England and Germany. He emerged with the rank of Captain in 1946 and continued his studies at Cornell under the GI bill graduating in 1948 with a BS/EE degree. He received his Professional Engineer degree in 1950 from NYU. He was V.P. and Chief Engineer of Lord Electric Co. in Rockefeller Center, New York City for 32 years retiring in 1983. Mr. Cleary was a member of the Advisory Board of the New York City Electrical Code Committee for eight years. He was preceded in death by a brother, James Cleary and sister, Delores Duffy both of NJ. Surviving are his wife, Peggy Cleary; daughter, Joann Heneghan and a grandson, Brian Heneghan both of Lincroft, NJ. Memorial services will be Noon, Saturday, October 29, 2005 at Goldfinch Funeral Home, Beach Chapel with visitation one hour prior to the service.
