The family will receive friends from 5:00-7:00, Friday at Goldfinch Funeral Home, Beach Chapel

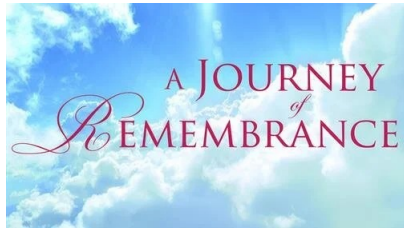
Graveside services will be 2:00 PM, Saturday at Ocean Woods Cemetery.
