Thomas Joseph McArdle age 91, died Thursday, October 9, 2014 at his residence.

Born in Stamford, CT, he was a son of the late James and Mary McArdle. Mr. McArdle was a WWII U.S. Army veteran in the 16th Field Artillery Observation Battalion, participating in the campaigns in Europe, Normandy, Northern France, Rhineland, Ardennes (Battle of the Bulge) and Central Europe. He retired as Benefits Manager from the Stamford Public Schools in 1994. Mr. McArdle served as Faithful Navigator of the LaFayette Assembly Fourth Degree Knights of Columbus and Captain of the Honor Guard. He was past president of the Newfield Swim and Tennis Club of Stamford and served as committee member and assistant Scoutmaster of Troop 1 in Stamford. He was a former member of St. Leo Roman Catholic Church, in Stamford serving as usher and working on various committees. Mr. McArdle was also a former member of the New Covenant House of Hospitality Advisory Board and active volunteer in preparing and serving meals at the local soup kitchen and was a current member of St. Michael Catholic Church, Garden City, SC.

Survivors include his wife Faith McArdle of Murrells Inlet; 3 sons, Thomas J. McArdle and his wife Susan of N. Yarmouth, ME, Michael McArdle of Myrtle Beach and Jeffrey McArdle of Myrtle Beach; a daughter, Maureen Albers and her husband Gary of Jacksonville, FL; 6 grandchildren, Michelle Jowers, Christie Albers, Kevin Albers, Jessica McArdle, Molly McArdle and Jeffrey

McArdle and 1 great grandchild, Lily Jowers.
