Thomas Charles Moehringer age 85, died Thursday, October 10, 2013 at Agape Rehabilitation in Conway.

Born in Brooklyn, New York, he was a son of the late Thomas C. and Henrietta Moran Moehringer. Thomas worked as a Supervisor for the NY Telephone and also as an Instructor for AT&T. He was a volunteer with the East Meadow NY Fire Department in the 1960's. He served as a Boy Scout Leader and Little League Coach and climbed Mt. Washington with his son. Thomas was a Eucharistic Minister at St. Michael Catholic Church. He supported and encouraged his wife Elizabeth's telling and sharing of her war time oral history and he loved boogie woogie music and playing the piano.
