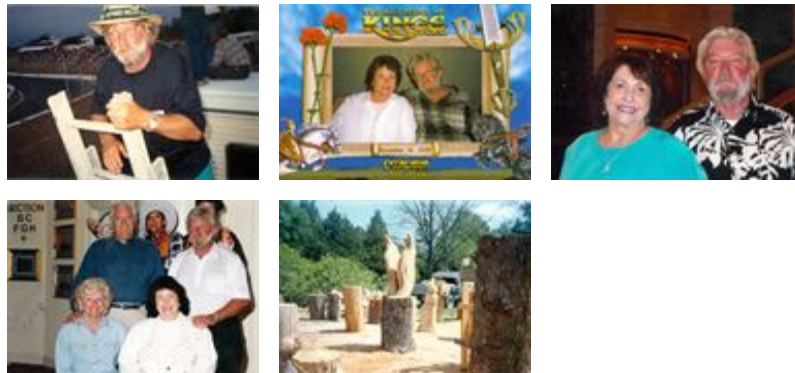

Family # 1 included daughter Lori and son James from Fort Erie, Ontario). Family # 3 included son, Harrison and daughter, Kirsten (Mom Debbie) from Muskoka, Ontario. Oddly, the numerous children from a variety of wives/partners were rarely acknowledged through Tom's difficult life of addiction and criminal convictions. His children received no support including financial or fatherly. His final wife/partner blocked contact between Tom and his children when they tried to connect. In the words of Tom's late son, Harrison ... To Each His Own. Tom's sister committed suicide by jumping off the Skylon Tower in Niagara Falls at a young age. Ideally Tom has found peace at last.
