May 28, 1940 - May 3, 2015

Thomas D. Quinn of Myrtle Beach, S.C., died May 3 after a long battle with cancer.

Born May 28, 1940, Tom was a Scranton native from Nativity, and attended Scranton Preparatory School and the Maryknoll Seminary in Clarks Summit. He served in the Navy as an aerographer's mate. He found his niche in residential construction and real estate development, and was known as a pioneer in timeshare and fractional ownership realty. He developed several major golf course and residential resort projects in South Carolina seaside areas. Whether negotiating a housing project for the U.S. Embassy in Russia or developing a global tracking system for containerized freight, Tom was an entrepreneur of the first order. Finally, he was a member of the board of Zero: The Project to End Prostate Cancer, and founded "Know Your Score" celebrity golf tournament to raise awareness for prostate cancer.

Tom is survived by his loving wife, Danna, Myrtle Beach, S.C.; and his devoted daughter, Mackey Quinn, Columbia Falls, Mont.; as well as 12 brothers and sisters and innumerable nieces and nephews.
