Conway..... Tillman I. Locklair, age 81, passed away Thursday, September 19, 2024 at his home.

Mr. Locklair was born in Darlington, SC, a son of the late Tillman I. Locklair, Sr. and the late Elizabeth Conyers Locklair Ivy. His stepfather was the late Herbert E. Ivy. He served in the US Navy from 1960-1966 as a Gunner's Mate 3rd class Anti-Submarine Warfare. Mr. Locklair served on the USS Borie (DD 704) during the Cuban Missile Crisis, Blockade Line, Mediterranean and North Atlantic deployments. His favorite accomplishment in the Navy was being able to see 26 different countries while serving. Mr. Locklair was an affectionate, dedicated, and hardworking individual who always put the needs of others ahead of his own. He met and married the love of his life, Linda E. Workman in Timmonsville, SC. He and Linda moved to Conway, SC, where they made their home. Mr. Locklair was known throughout Conway for his giving spirit and innate ability to manage details. He had a very successful career in retail until he retired to spend time with his beloved wife and family. Mr. Locklair was a faithful member of First United Methodist Church, Conway for many years and was ready to lend a helping hand and offer words of guidance to whomever needed it.
