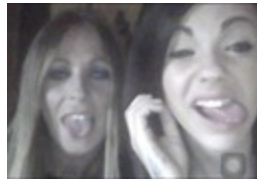
Always. And forever.

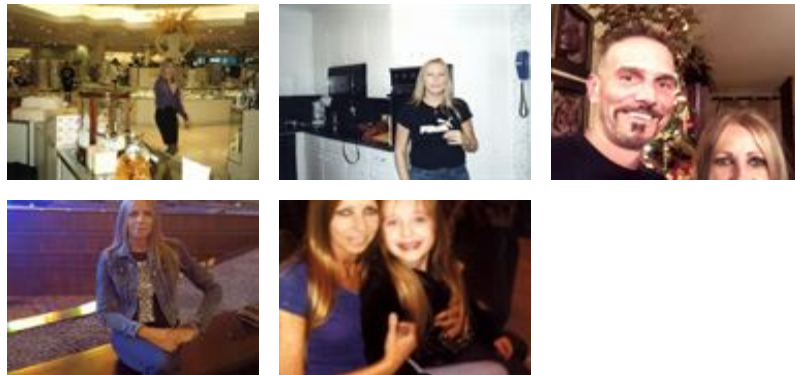
