Jack Ulysses Barney Frost, IV. Jack Frost, founder of Shiloh Place Ministries, pastor, author, teacher and accomplished sea captain went home to be with Father God March 5, 2007 after a heroic battle with cancer. Jack became known as Top Hook in the Southeast United States. He accredits this accomplishment to Captain Al Kline who taught him the way of the sea and became a father figure who imparted to him confidence, self-worth and belief that it is possible to overcome any adversity found at sea or in life. Jack served as an ordained minister for the Salvation Army in Conway, SC from 1984 to 1986. From 1989 to 1991 he served as the Pastor of Evangelism for Evangel Cathedral in Spartanburg, SC. Shiloh Place Ministries, birthed in 1991, has become an international ministry touching and impacting the world with the message of the true heart of Father God and His love. Jack's books, "Experiencing the Father's Embrace", and "Spiritual Slavery to Spiritual Sonship" have touched and healed the hearts of millions of people throughout the nations. Through his incredible gift of leadership, he has raised up thousands of leaders and ministers who carry this message transforming our world with a restored picture of the Father heart of God. Jack was born in St. Augustine, FL, son of the late Shirley S Frost and Barney Frost.
