Vincent (Jim) Aglieco, age 100, passed away peacefully on Sunday, June 28, 2026 at Grand Strand Medical Center.

Born in Bronx, NY, and later a resident of White Plains, NY, Vincent is the son of the late Gasper and Mary Aglieco. A proud veteran of the United States Army, Vincent served his country during World War II as a Sergeant and Bow Gunner. He fought under General George S. Patton during the Battle of the Bulge, one of the war's most significant and difficult campaigns. He also helped liberate several prisoner camps. Following his service in the Army, Vincent worked for New York Telephone and Verizon. In his retirement, Vincent moved to Myrtle Beach with his wife, Dorothy, where they had their dream home and made many lifelong friends. The family extends their heartfelt appreciation to the compassionate caregivers who cared for Vincent, who became much more than caregivers. Vincent is preceded in death by his wife of 61 years, Dorothy J. Aglieco.

Survivors include his children, Arthur Aglieco (Rose), Susan McDonald (John); grandchildren, Jordan Aglieco, Juliana Robertson (Paul); great grandchildren, Caleb Robertson, and Amelia Robertson.
