Violet Elizabeth Fynmore, age 89, died Saturday, October 1, 2011 at her daughter's home in Murrells Inlet, SC.

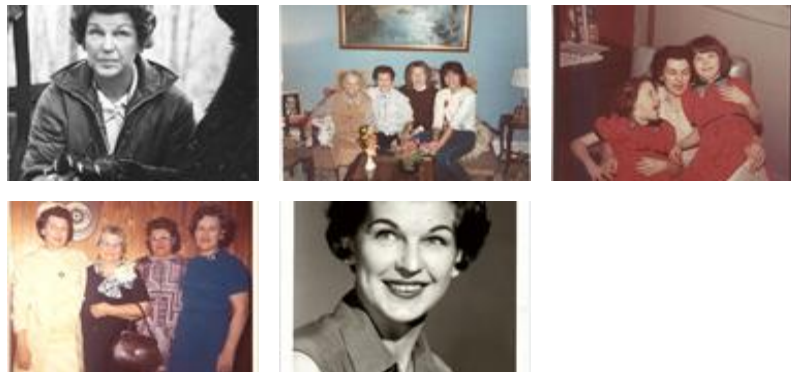

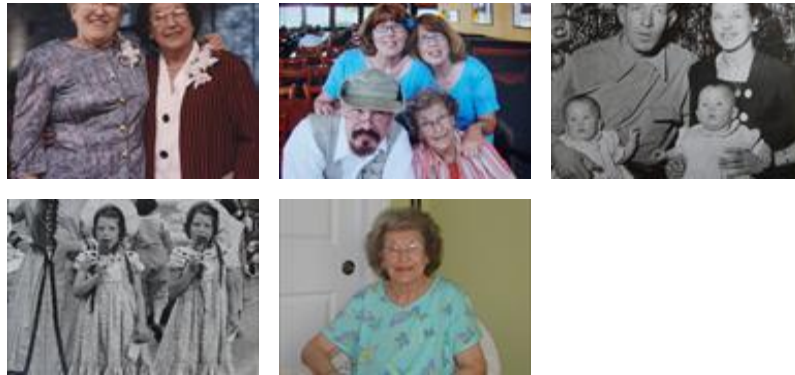
