Virginia Floyd Powell, age 79, wife of the late Lonzie Powell, died Sunday, June 19, 2005 at her son's home in Manning, SC. Mrs. Powell was born in Conway, a daughter of the late Francis Marvin and Minnie Vaught Floyd. She was a lifelong member of the First United Methodist Church of Conway. She was dedicated to God's glory and active in her church, and demonstrated that love by her faithfulness in His service. She served on many church committees, taught Sunday school and served as Church Hostess for many years. Mrs Powell had a deep concern for shut-ins within her community and served on the Caregivers Committee. In addition, she was Bereavement Chairperson for the church for many years. She was a member of the Family Fellowship Class and the Bessie Henry Circle. Mrs. Powell was a 1942 graduate of Conway High School and attended Winthrop College where she received her BA Degree, and received her Master's Degree in Education from the University of South Carolina. She was an elementary school teacher in the Conway City School System for 32 years, retiring in 1980. Her only daughter, Lannis Powell Jordan passed away in December 2002. 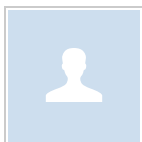
