



Vivian Spencer Singleton

May 6, 1935 - June 22, 2022

Conway.....Vivian Spencer Singleton, a life-long resident of Conway, South Carolina and wife of the late Ronald Earl Singleton, passed peacefully on Wednesday, June 22, 2022 in Charleston, South Carolina.

Mrs. Singleton was born on May 6, 1935, to the late James William Spencer and Helen "Sudie" Stevens Spencer. She was predeceased by her parents; husband; a son, Hugh David Singleton; a sister, Mary Francis Reed; and half-siblings, Lavada Altman, Macy Stephens, Mack Stevens, Heyward Stevens, Don Stevens, and Hollis Stevens. Inspired by her love of nature and passion for flowers, she was a member of the Conway Garden Club, and, with her son, David, spear-headed the effort to plant the beautiful azaleas at Conway High School during his freshman year as a student there. Other civic accomplishments included playing a pivotal role in the annexation of Quattlebaum Acres within the city limits of Conway garnering her the nickname, "Mayor of Quattlebaum Acres." Her crowning achievement, however, was raising her children. Professionally, Vivian worked in the legal field before retiring as Program Secretary for the Horry County School District. She was a member of First Baptist Church of Conway where she attended the Sunshine Sunday School Class regularly and was part of the inaugural class of Coastal Carolina.

Survivors include: her daughter, Jennifer Singleton (Robin) of Charleston, South Carolina; son, James Gregory Singleton, of Springfield, Virginia; granddaughters, Wallis Anne Singleton of Mount Pleasant, South Carolina,

and Ashlee Singleton Gilligan (Brennan) of Warrenton, Virginia; and great-granddaughters, Virginia Fay and Anna James Gilligan.

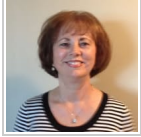
