Vivienne Roser Hammond, 83, died on June 17, 2011 at The Lakes at Litchfield in Pawley's Island, SC. Vivienne was born in Chicago, Illinois, daughter of the late Gerald V. and Dorothy F. Roser.

Vivienne will be remembered as a loving and gracious wife, mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, sister, and friend.
