Mr. Walter Charles Wise, age 58, died Thursday, October 11, 2007 at Grand Strand Regional Medical Center due to injuries sustained in a motorcycle accident. Mr. Wise was born July 23, 1949 in Trenton, New Jersey, the son of the late Henry Charles Wise and Lettittia Whitlock Allen. He was a U.S. Marine veteran serving our country in the Vietnam War. He was a Past Master of the Masonic Lodge #199 in Pemberton, N.J. Mr. Wise had retired as an Associate Administrator of Corrections at East Jersey State Prison and New Jersey State Prison. Mr. Wise was an avid motorcyclist and golfer. He was a loving husband, father, and grandfather. He is survived by his wife, Barbara Wise of Murrells Inlet; son, Samuel Wise and his wife, Mary, of Hamilton Sq., N.J.; four grandchildren, John, Breanna, Kaley, and Sammy; daughter, Michelle Taylor of Dallas, T.X.; father, Edgar Allen of Trenton, N.J.; sister, Anna Egan and husband, Art, of Yardville, N.J.; nephews, Brian and Jeffrey Egan of N.J.; mother-in-law, Ann Ronaldo of Murrells Inlet, originally of Trenton, N.J.; and brother-in-law, Paul Ronaldo of Missoula, Mont. Services will be 1 p.m. Monday, October 15, 2007 at Goldfinch Funeral Home, Beach Chapel with the Rev. Jim Lewis officiating. Entombment will follow in Hillcrest Mausoleum. 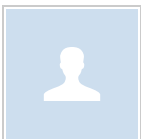

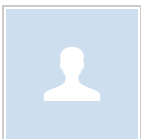
