Mr. Kitowicz graduated Magna Cum Laude from Tufts University and received his Master of Engineering Science from Penn State University. He was a member of Tau Beta Pi Honor Society. Walt spent most of his years working with the space program setting up stations in Germany and San Salvador in order to track the astronauts after launch. Walt spent several years teaching College level Mathematics in Upstate NY. He retired from Textron in MA after working on the MX Missile Program. The family moved to Pawleys Island from Andover, MA in 1997. Survivors include his wife of 44 years, Patricia Bjorseth Kitowicz; children, Walter Anthony (Tony) Kitowicz and his wife Marinda, Thaddeus William (Tad) Kitowicz and his wife Teresa, Amelia Jeanne (Amy) Kitowicz, Jennifer Mary (Jenn) Kitowicz; grandchildren, Joseph, Savannah, Anthony, Nicolas; sister-in-law, Barbara Bjorseth; sister, Ann Wojzsnis and her husband Edward; and several nieces and nephews.
