Walton Singleton, age 83, passed away Tuesday, February 21, 2017 at Conway Medical Center.

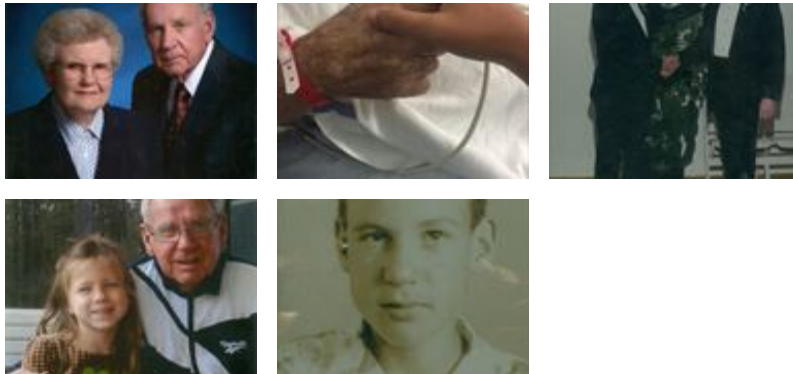
