Warren Lamar Jackson age 84, died Monday, June 10, 2013 at Waccamaw Community Hospital after a short illness.

Born on December 8, 1928 in Richmond, GA, he was a son of the late E.D. and Ernestine Jackson. Warren graduated from Richmond Academy.
