



## Wayne M. Sessions

March 10, 1942 - December 21, 2014

Conway...Mr. Wayne M. Sessions, 72, died December 21, 2014 at Conway Medical Center of complications from a stroke.

Born and raised in Conway he was the son of the late Bruce B. Sessions and the late Lodie R. Sessions. Wayne was a life-long resident of Conway.
