Wayne C. Wieder, age 83, passed away early in the morning, Saturday, January 11, 2014.

He was born on September 12, 1930 in Emmaus, Pennsylvania to Clarence "Match" and Edna Wieder. He attended Penn State University and then served his country as a Staff Sergeant in the United States Air Force. After a successful career at General Electric, he followed his calling in the Ministry, serving as the pastor for two church communities in the Cincinnati, Ohio area. Upon retirement, Wayne continued serving others by delivering sermons and teaching bible studies to various church congregations, non-profit organizations and senior healthcare facilities.

Surviving Wayne is his wife, Barbara Leeds Wieder; his son, Charles "Chuck" Wieder; his daughters, Kim Wieder Gerhardt and Kristine Wieder Ritchie; a stepson, Mark Leeds; a stepdaughter, Melody Leeds and several grandchildren.
