Wesley Cunningham, age 87, passed away on Monday, May 16, 2022 peacefully at his residence with his family by his side.

Born in Akron, OH, he was a son of the late Fred and Edna Cunningham. Wesley held a Masters of Counseling Degree from Kent State University. He was a teacher, a counselor and he retired as the Director of Pupil Personnel for the Springfield School District. He served as an officer in the US Army during the Berlin Wall Crisis. He commanded the Akron, OH Army Reserve unit and was honorably discharged as a Captain. He loved all sports; you wouldn't find him missing any football games, especially Ohio State Football. He and his wife, Roseann loved to travel. He'd visited all 50 states and many countries and in fact, may hold the Guinness record for travel cruises. Both he and Roseann are members of Oasis of Hope, Jeff Wood Ministries in Oceanside Village.

In addition to his parents, Wesley was predeceased by his brother David Cunningham.

He is survived by his wife of 64 years, Roseann; 1 daughter, Joy Miller and her husband Ed of Nebo, WV; 2 sons: Mark Cunningham and his wife Laura of Indian Trail, NC, Kirk Cunningham and his wife Pam of Tallahassee, FL; 8 grand children and 6 great grandchildren (with 2 soon to be here) and his sister, Janet Frame.
