



Wilbur Blondell Hardwick

September 13, 1929 - March 24, 2016

Wilbur Blondell Hardwick, age 86, went to be with his Lord and Savior on Thursday, March 24, 2016 at Conway Medical Center after a long illness. Mr. Hardwick was born September 13, 1929 in Conway, SC, a son of the late William Arthur Hardwick and Pearl Bellamy Hardwick.

He was a member of Greenwood Baptist Church for 66 years and served as Sunday School Teacher, Music Director, Deacon, and Deacon Emeritus. Mr. Hardwick and his wife worked 6 years with the Home Mission Board and assisted in starting churches in South Carolina, Iowa, and Michigan. He was a farmer and a carpenter, and retired from Hardwick Construction. Mr. Hardwick was preceded in death by three brothers, Wade, Tommy, and one who died at birth. The family is so grateful to his caregivers at Conway Manor, the Conway Medical Center Critical Care Unit and to Max Nobles for taking him home one last time.

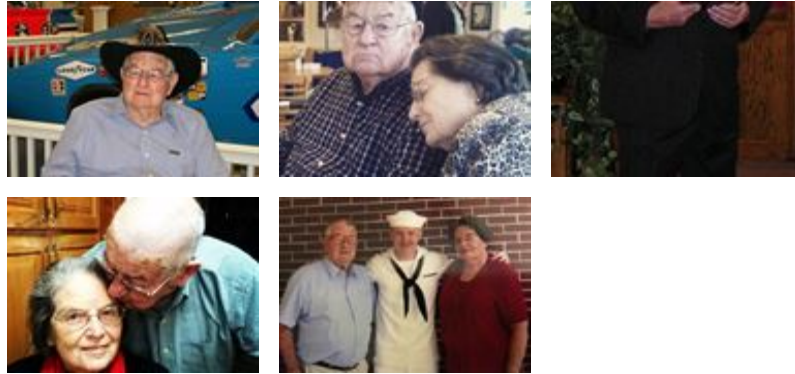
