Conway...W.L. "Stick" Chestnut, age 97, of Lakeside Drive, died Thursday, September 25, 2014 at Kingston Nursing Center.

Stick was born in Conway, a son of the late W.B. and Grace Lewis Chestnut. He was a member and former deacon of First Baptist Church in Conway and was chairman of the committee that helped form Langston Baptist Church. Stick was a U.S. Army Air Corps Veteran of WWII and prior to retirement, he worked in the parts department at Palmetto Chevrolet and was with the organization for more than 50 years. He was very active in several civic organizations in the Conway Area. Stick was a former Boy Scout Troop Leader for many years, was a member and former president of the Conway Kiwanis Club and was a member of the American Legion Post # 111. He was blessed with the ability of "talking" off warts and was well known in the community for this.
