Conway-..William Fred "Freddie" Brown, age 65, died from an extended illness on December 29, 2010 at Kingston Nursing Center. Mr. Brown was born in Conway, SC, a son of the late William Fred Brown, Sr. and Letha Hucks Brown. He graduated from Conway High School in 1962. Mr. Brown measured tobacco acreage for the Agricultural Soil Conservation Service and served on the Bucksport Water and Sewer Board. He farmed tobacco, soybeans, and corn from 1967 to 2000, alongside his brother Harold Brown. Mr. Brown was the music and choir director for over 30 years at Greenwood Baptist Church, where he was also Deacon Emeritus. He was a wonderful father, grandfather, brother, and friend, with a lifetime of lay ministry to his community. Freddie is survived by his three daughters, Jeanine Newbury and husband Nathan, Tracy Kempinski and husband Stephen, and Kristi Johnson and husband Russell; a brother, Harold Brown and wife Geanean; a sister, Evelyn Richardson; and three grandchildren, Blake Cook, Will Johnson and Sidney Johnson, all of Conway. Funeral services will be held 11:00 AM Saturday at Greenwood Baptist Church with Rev. Richard Krieg officiating.
