William Reynolds Rempfer of Surfside Beach, South Carolina, died on November 30, 2016 at the age of 66. William Sr. is survived by wife Cheryl, sons William Jr., Adam, Sean, daughters Jessica, Brianna, April, 8 Grandchildren and sister Dorothea Gollaher.

William "Bill" was born in New York City, New York and raised in Florham Park, NJ by parents William Rempfer and Mildred Reynolds. Serving his community, Bill served as a Special Police Officer on the Florham Park Police Department from 1981 to 1992. Bill was a hardworking and successful business owner all of his life. In 1995, Bill and Cheryl opened DeFalco's Automotive and Towing in New Jersey. 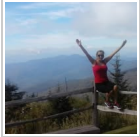
