William Henry Robertson, Jr., age 87, passed away Wednesday, February 7, 2018 at his residence.

Born February 1, 1931 in Danville, VA, he was the son of the late William Henry Robertson, Sr. and Theresa Odell Walters Robertson. He was a high school graduate of Hermitage High School in Richmond, Virginia. Mr. Robertson served his country in the United States Army from 1948-1955, during the Korean Conflict. He retired from Santee Cooper- Grainger Station as an E and I Technician. William was a member of Horry Post 111 of the American Legion and a member of Langston Baptist Church in Conway. He served as a former member of Conway Kiwanis. Mr. Robertson had an avid love for remote control airplanes, HAM radio operating, and photography. He will be remembered as a devoted husband, father, and grandfather. Along with his parents, Mr. Robertson was preceded in death by two brothers, Carroll and Joe Robertson, and a sister, Frances Mays.
