William Thomas Caulfield, 64, died Saturday, November 3, 2007 at Waccamaw Community Hospital after a brief illness. Mr. Caulfield was born on April 14, 1943, in Brooklyn, New York, eldest son of the late Edward and Marie Caulfield. Bill, as he was known to friends, was a retired detective with the New York City Police Department and past owner of Target Investigations of Long Island, New York. He was a graduate of John J. University, New York City, with a BS in Criminal Justice and an MBA in Business from Columbia University, New York City.
