William Edward Teal, 88, passed away Wednesday, December 21, 2017.

Born August 26, 1929 in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late Merritt Davis and Edna Macauley Teal. Mr. Teal proudly served his country and was an Army Veteran of the Korean Conflict 7th Division 32nd Regiment. 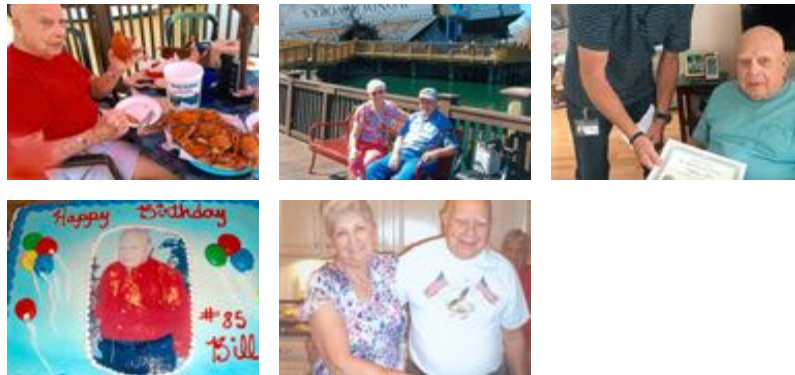
