Mr. Billy Joe Calhoun, 89, widower of the late Julia Calhoun, passed away Sunday, December 13, 2020 at Conway Medical Center following a brief illness.

Born October 23, 1931 in Conway, Mr. Calhoun was the son of the late Lonnie Lee Calhoun, Sr. and the late Virginia Johnson Calhoun. He was a member of First United Methodist Church of Conway and the John McCutcheon Sunday School Class. Mr. Calhoun was a graduate of Conway High School and was a former member of the Conway Lions Club. He and his family owned and operated Calhoun's Red and White Grocery Store and Calhoun's Cash and Carry.
