Whiteville, NC...Miss Wilma Deane Stricklin, age 81, passed away Tuesday, August 7, 2007 at her home following an illness.

Miss Stricklin was born September 14, 1925 in Tribbey, Kentucky a daughter of the late S.F. Stricklin, Sr. and the late Cora Jane Williams Stricklin. She was a veteran of the United States Navy serving during the Korean War. Miss Stricklin had worked at Northern Illinois University and the University of Southern California as a professor and an administrator. She also had a scholarship and an award named in her honor at those universities. She was instrumental in the establishment of the Desert House of Prayer in Sedona, Arizona. It is there that a stone is inscribed with one of her favorite Bible verses, Psalm 46:10: "Be still, and know that I am God."
