Zenobia Deliyannis Sessions, wife of William A. Sessions of Atlanta, GA, and Conway, SC, passed away on Thursday afternoon in the company of family and friends. She was 87 years old.

Jenny, as she was known, was born in Florina, Greece, and grew up in Kyparissia and Athens, where she attended the French Academy. In 1961, she married William Sessions in Athens, and moved to the US, where she attend Georgia State University and obtained a masters at Emory University. She taught French and Latin for almost 20 years in the DeKalb County school system, mainly at Tucker High School.

She is survived by her husband, two sons, Andrew and Eric, and by one grandson, Nicholas, who she adored.

Graveside services will be held at 1:00PM Monday, November 30, 2015 at Lakeside Cemetery, in Conway, SC, officiated by Rev. Angelo C. Pappas.
